# Rules and regulations of international tournaments for national teams

The Rules and Regulations of International Tournaments for National Teams is a document aimed at providing guidance and establishing standards for the organization of international competitions involving national teams. The document outlines the criteria for the selection of participating teams, the format of the tournament, and the rules and regulations that govern the conduct of the event. These guidelines are designed to ensure that the tournaments are conducted in a fair and transparent manner, with the best interests of the participating teams in mind. The document serves as a reference for tournament organizers, national team managers, and all those involved in the planning and execution of international tournaments for national teams.

# Wheelchair floorball

The international wheelchair floorball tournaments are played according to the valid IFF Rules, with the additions of ICWF

# **Wheelchairs**

- The international wheelchair floorball tournaments are played according to the valid wheelchair safety rules of ICWF
- Representative of ICWF (or referee) will control technical parameters of wheelchairs before the first tournaments match and during the tournaments

# Rules for fastening inside nets in goal constructions

The International wheelchair floorball tournaments are played according to the valid rules for fastening inside nets in goal constructions of ICWF

# Minimal handicap

- Each player on the national team roster must comply with the minimum handicap rule of ICWF
- The representative of ICWF will verify the handicap level according to the specified minimum handicap of ICWF.

# Playing time

Standard playing time according to the IFF Rules.

#### Field size

Standard field size according to the IFF Rules.

#### **Referees**

Referees with valid national floorball license are nominated in co-operation with the International Floorball Federation (IFF).

# Preliminary system

- The teams are divided into two, or more groups, but if there are fewer than 6 teams, there can be only one group
- The ranking in the group will decide your opponent in the play off
- All play off matches will be decided by the cup system (direct elimination)

# Insurance

- Every player is taking part in the wheelchair floorball tournaments on his own risk. The participants are not insured by the organizer.
- The organizer is not responsible for any loss, damage or injury of the participants during the tournaments.

# <u>Awards</u>

- The winning team will be awarded a trophy, and the first three teams will be awarded medals (up to 15 per team)
- Awards will also be given to the best male and female players, best goalkeeper, and top scorer of the tournament.

#### **Transportation**

The organizer does not provide transportation.

# **Registration**

Teams always register by sending an application form to the email of the organizer of the specific wheelchair floorball tournament. After completing the registration, teams can add or correct information, such as accommodation, training schedules, or requests for friendly matches according to specific dates set by the organizer. By sending and subsequently confirming the registration for the specific tournament, the national team agrees to the participation conditions, including GDPR compliance.

#### Tournament fee

- The fee amount is determined by the organizer
- It must be on the organizer's account by the deadline set by the organizer
- The organizer reserves the right to exclude the team from the tournament if the fee is not paid by the deadline

- In the case of cancellation of the team's registration for the specific wheelchair floorball tournament, the registration fee will not be refunded
- Instructions for payment (including all proforma invoices) are always sent by the organizer after the registration form has been submitted on the tournament website
- Bank transfer fees are always covered by the registering team.
